RULES

Completed Entry and Permission Forms are to be received by **Thursday, July 6th, 2017**.

All Participants:

1. The most important rule is to **HAVE FUN**.
2. All entries should be entertaining to a family audience comprised primarily of children.
3. **All entries are to check-in at the "Information Booth" located in front of Jenny Emery School.**
4. **It is expected that all entries be at least 65% decorated. Antique vehicles are exempt.**
5. Minimum age for walkers or marching parade participants is 7 years.
6. There is a float height restriction of 3.35 metres (11 feet) from the ground to the top of the display.
7. All equestrian and live animal entrants must provide their own clean-up crew who shall be easily identifiable as part of the group.
8. Candy **SHALL NOT** be thrown from the vehicles/floats but rather be distributed by having someone walk along side of the float and toss the candy into the crowd (to the sidewalks or grassed areas).
9. **DO NOT** throw water or have water balloons or water guns.
10. Floats carrying passengers are required to be constructed with safety railings around the perimeter of the trailer or passengers shall be securely seated while vehicle/float is in motion.
11. Once your entry/float has started along the parade route, no one shall board the same.
12. Entries **MUST** return to the disembarking area to disperse at 11 Street and 22 Avenue.
13. If a float will utilize a combustible fuel powered generator, or other possible fire hazards, participants **MUST** have a minimum 10 LB. ABC chemical fire extinguisher.
14. All vehicle operators shall have a valid operator's license and **MUST** provide proof of liability insurance in the amount of \$2 million.
15. Commercial signs or acknowledgements of donations may appear on the side skirts of the float/vehicle.

16. Demonstrations or performances shall not impede the forward motion of the Parade.
17. Participants in the parade shall not consume or create the impression of consuming alcohol beverages and shall refrain from smoking during their participation in the parade.
18. Participants must ride on the inside of the float (and not) sit on the edge of the float trailer with feet dangling over the sides. All children shall be securely seated and supervised on the floats during the parade.
19. **The Settler Days Committee makes the final decision on the acceptance or rejection of all applications.**
20. The Town of Coaldale, the Coaldale & District Chamber of Commerce, Parade committee and staff assume no responsibility in connection with and makes no representation as to the safety of any parade entry, in whole or in part, solely by compliance with the parade rules and regulations.
21. **Judging Criteria:**
Possible 10 points for each category (Total 100)

Workmanship – Originality; Quality of Work
Design – Originality; Animation/Lights; Creativity
General Effect – “Wow Factor”
Overall Theme
Music
People – Costumes; Enthusiasm
